2. Mr. Deepak presented the financial status of the trust and suggested identifying more sponsors to strengthen the trust's activities. He also recommended appointing coordinators to visit nearby villages and create awareness to improve student enrollment.
3. Apart from the above sponsorships, Mr. M. Malaichamy has contributed an advance of Rs. 40,000 and has been continuously paying a monthly rent of Rs. 5,000 since the inception of the centre.

4. Mr. M. Malaichamy proposed starting a new coaching centre **at Tirupuvanam from October 5th, 2025**, with an awareness programme in both Tirupuvanam and Kariapatti on the same day, involving successful government exam achievers as resource persons.
5. He also suggested placing banners in Kariapatti (near the bus stand) and Tirupuvanam.
6. It was decided that Mr. Rajaboopathy's Radian IAS Academy would handle classes at both centres, to which he agreed.
7. Colonel G. Pandian expressed his willingness to coordinate activities alongside centre coordinators whenever required, as he is available after retirement.
8. A horticulture student from the family of the Marudhu Brothers expressed her aspiration to become a Group 1 officer and requested sponsorship; Mr. Rajaboopathy of Radian IAS Academy immediately accepted to sponsor her Group 1 coaching and guidance.
9. Mr. Rajesh also proposed collecting **Rs.500 per month** from willing contributors to strengthen the financial position of the trust, and all members agreed to implement this.
10. The invited guests, including Mr. Rajesh, Mr. R. Srinivasan (Advocate), Mr. Nagaselvam, and Mr. Suriyanarayanan, shared valuable suggestions for the trust's growth and sustainability.
